The Litany & Prayers of Reparation to the Holy Face For Sundays & Holydays

To be recited preferably before the Blessed Sacrament or before the picture of the Holy Face.

Prayer of Reparation In Praise of the Holy Name of God "The Golden Arrow"

May the most holy, most sacred, most adorable, most incomprehensible, and most ineffable Name of God be always praised, blessed, loved, adored, and glorified in Heaven, on earth and under the earth, by all the creatures of God, and by the Sacred Heart of Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar.

Amen.

This prayer was dictated by Our Lord Himself to Sister Mary of St. Peter. Our Savior complained of blasphemy, saying that this frightful sin wounds His Divine Heart more grievously than all other sins for it was like a "poisoned Arrow".

He called this Prayer "The Golden Arrow" saying that those who would recite this Prayer would pierce Him delightfully and also heal other wounds inflicted on Him by the malice of sinners.

This prayer is regarded as the basis of the work of reparation. Members are urged to recite it daily together with an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be.

O Jesus, Who in Thy cruel Passion didst become the reproach of men and the Man of Sorrows, I venerate Thy Divine Face. Once it shone with the beauty and sweetness of the Divinity; now for my sake It is become as the face of a leper. Yet in that disfigured Countenance I recognize Thy infinite love and I am consumed with loving Thee and of making Thee loved by all mankind. The tears that streamed in such abundance from Thy eyes are to me as precious pearls which I delight to gather, that with their infinite worth I may ransom the souls of poor sinners.
